Jess Lourey, author of the Murder-by-Month mysteries will be presenting at the library on **Saturday, May 6th at 10 AM** in the Foot Room.

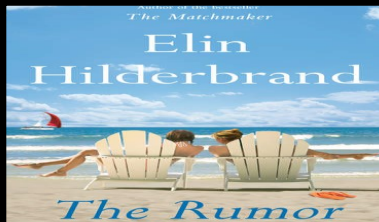

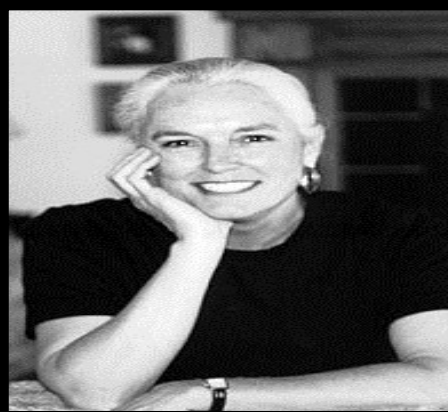
