4. YOU MAY ENTER MORE THAN ONCE, BUT EACH BINGO CARD ENTERED MUST CONTAIN A DIFFERENT COMBINATION. PARTICIPANTS COMPLETING MULTIPLE ENTRIES CANNOT USE A TITLE ON MORE THAN ONE ENTRY.
